



BBIA Uniform Policy 2025/2026 academic year

School Uniform is required for all BBIA students from Reception till YEAR 11. At BBIA we want our students to feel comfortable, and the wearing of uniform indicates pride in personal appearance, acceptance of shared goals, support for the values BBIA seeks to achieve and creates a sense of community.

It is important that all students follow the uniform code and abide by its rules. If students are not dressed appropriately in school uniform, without an agreed reason, they will not be allowed to join their classes until they arrive in the correct uniform, and we may also send the students home to change.

If any student persistently infringes the uniform code, this will be viewed in exactly the same way as the persistent refusal to follow any other instruction and the appropriate sanction will be applied.

BBIA does not permit individual fashion statements such as extreme hair styles or colours, designer-or decorated clothing or footwear.

All shirts, polo-shirts, T-shirts, sweaters, cardigans, hoodies, dresses and PE trousers, must present the school logo.

All items of uniform and bags are to be clearly marked or labelled.

From year 2 till year 11 PE uniforms to be worn accepted only on PE lessons.

BOYS

Reception - YEAR 1



Shirt

Plain white collared Polo-Shirt (short or long sleeves). The top button should be fastened.



Trousers

Plain navy blue regular or slim fitting trousers, which must be straight cut or navy blue tracksuit bottoms with school logo. Trousers should not be worn below the waist (no underwear should be visible). JEANS, LEGGINGS and CORDS are not permitted



Socks

Plain black, navy blue ankle socks or below the knee socks.



Sweater/Jumper

Plain navy blue, V-neck sweater, hoodie or plain navy blue zip-up fleece jumper to be worn in cold weather as needed, not tucked in at the waist. No other form of sweater/jumper is acceptable.



Shoes

Plain dark leather (or leather look) shoes with flat heels. Plain dark ankle boots are also acceptable. Plain dark leather or leather look trainers or sport shoes are allowed without visible brandmarks.

BOYS

YEAR 2 - YEAR 6



Shirt

Plain white collared Polo-Shirt (short or long sleeves). The top button should be fastened.



Trousers

Plain navy blue regular or slim fitting trousers, which must be straight cut. Trousers should not be worn below the waist (no underwear should be visible). JEANS, LEGGINGS, TRACKSUIT BOTTOMS and CORDS are not permitted



Shoes

Plain dark leather (or leather look) shoes with flat heels. Plain dark ankle boots are also acceptable. Plain dark leather or leather look trainers or sport shoes are allowed without visible brandmarks.



Sweater/Jumper

Plain navy blue, V-neck sweater, hoodie or plain navy blue zip-up fleece jumper to be worn in cold weather as needed, not tucked in at the waist. No other form of sweater/jumper is acceptable.



Socks

Plain black, navy blue ankle socks or below the knee socks.



GIRLS

Year 2 - YEAR 6



Shirt

Plain white collared Polo-Shirt (short or long sleeves). The top button should be fastened.



Trousers

Plain navy blue regular or slim fitting trousers, which must be straight cut. Trousers should not be worn below the waist (no underwear should be visible). We have given the girls the option of wearing school trousers, a skirt or a pinafore dress. JEANS, LEGGINGS, TRACKSUIT BOTTOMS and CORDS are not permitted



Tights

Plain black, navy blue or flesh coloured (no patterns).



Skirt/dress

Plain navy blue skirt or pinafore dress. It needs to be just above knee-length (maximum 5 cm above the knee)



Sweater/Cardigan/Jumper

Plain navy blue, V-neck sweater, plain navy blue knitted cardigan (zip-up or buttoned), hoodie or plain navy blue zip-up fleece jumper to be worn in cold weather as needed, not tucked in at the waist. No other form of sweater\cardigan is acceptable.



Shoes

Plain dark leather (or leather look) shoes with flat heels. Plain dark ankle boots are also acceptable. Plain dark leather or leather look trainers or sport shoes are allowed without visible brandmarks.



Socks

Plain black, navy blue ankle socks or below the knee socks.

GIRLS

YEAR 7 - YEAR 9



Shirt

Plain white shirt (short or long sleeves), or plain white collared Polo-Shirt (short or long sleeves), tucked into trousers at all times. The top button should be fastened.



Trousers

Plain navy blue regular or slim fitting trousers, which must be straight cut. Trousers should not be worn below the waist (no underwear should be visible). We have given the girls the option of wearing school trousers, a skirt or a pinafore dress. JEANS, LEGGINGS, TRACKSUIT BOTTOMS and CORDS are not permitted



Skirt/dress

Plain navy blue skirt or pinafore dress. It needs to be just above knee-length (maximum 5 cm above the knee)



Sweater/Cardigan/Jumper

Plain navy blue, V-neck sweater, plain navy blue knitted cardigan (zip-up or buttoned) or plain navy blue zip-up fleece jumper to be worn in cold weather as needed, not tucked in at the waist. No other form of sweater\cardigan is acceptable.



Tights

Plain black, navy blue or flesh coloured (no patterns).



Shoes

Plain dark leather (or leather look) shoes with flat heels. Plain dark ankle boots are also acceptable. Plain dark leather or leather look trainers or sport shoes are allowed without visible brandmarks.



Ties-scarf

All students from YEAR 7 and above must wear a school tie. Ties must be pulled smartly up to the top shirt button.



Socks

Plain black, navy blue ankle socks or below the knee socks.



BOYS

YEAR 7 - YEAR 9



Shirt

Plain white shirt (short or long sleeves), or plain white collared Polo-Shirt (short or long sleeves), tucked into trousers at all times. The top button should be fastened.



Trousers

Plain navy blue regular or slim fitting trousers, which must be straight cut. Trousers should not be worn below the waist (no underwear should be visible). JEANS, LEGGINGS, TRACKSUIT BOTTOMS and CORDS are not permitted



Socks

Plain black, navy blue ankle socks or below the knee socks.



Sweater

Plain navy blue, V-neck sweater or plain navy blue zip-up fleece jumper to be worn in cold weather as needed, not tucked in at the waist. No other form of sweater is acceptable.



Ties

All students from YEAR 7 and above must wear a school tie. Ties must be pulled smartly up to the top shirt button.



Shoes

Plain navy blue regular or slim fitting trousers, which must be straight cut or navy blue tracksuit bottoms with school logo. Trousers should not be worn below the waist (no underwear should be visible). We have given the girls the option of wearing school trousers, a skirt or a pinafore dress. JEANS, LEGGINGS and CORDS are not permitted



Tights

Plain black, navy blue or flesh coloured (no patterns).



Skirt/dress

Plain navy blue skirt or pinafore dress. It needs to be just above knee-length (maximum 5 cm above the knee)



Sweater/Cardigan/Jumper

Plain navy blue, V-neck sweater, plain navy blue knitted cardigan (zip-up or buttoned), hoodie or plain navy blue zip-up fleece jumper to be worn in cold weather as needed, not tucked in at the waist. No other form of sweater/cardigan is acceptable.

Reception - YEAR 1



GIRLS

YEAR 10 - Year 11



Shirt

Plain white shirt (short or long sleeves), tucked into trousers at all times. The top button should be fastened.



Socks

Plain black, navy blue ankle socks or below the knee socks.



Ties-scarf

All students from YEAR 10 and above must wear a school tie. Ties must be pulled smartly upto the top shirt button.



Trousers

Plain navy blue regular or slim fitting trousers, which must be straight cut. Trousers should not be worn below the waist (no underwear should be visible). We have given the girls the option of wearing school trousers, or a skirt. JEANS, LEGGINGS, TRACKSUIT BOTTOMS and CORDS are not permitted



Sweater/Cardigan

Plain navy blue, V-neck sweater, plain navy blue knitted cardigan (zip-up or buttoned) or plain navy blue zip-up fleece jumper to be worn in cold weather as needed, not tucked in at the waist. No other form of jumper\cardigan is acceptable.



Skirt/dress

Plain navy blue skirt. It needs to be just above knee-length (maximum 5 cm above the knee)



Shoes

Plain dark leather (or leather look) shoes with flat heels. Plain dark ankle boots are also acceptable. Plain dark leather or leather look trainers or sport shoes are allowed without visible brandmarks.



Tights

Plain black, navy blue or flesh coloured (no patterns).

PE Kit

Reception - YEAR 11

All students from Reception till Year 11 must have the following in their PE kit:



Plain white crew-neck T-Shirt



Navy blue tracksuit bottoms or navy blue shorts (in hot weather or gym training)



Navy blue hoodie (this item is optional, but no other hoodie is acceptable)



Sport socks



Trainers (any colour)

PE uniforms accepted only on PE lessons. (From year 2 - year 11)
